The Groundwater Discharge Permit will allow the applicant to continue to discharge 26,000 gallons per day of treated sanitary wastewater from Lincoln Woods Housing, a 222 bedroom residential complex and an adjacent 34,155 square foot commercial development at Lincoln Mall to the ground waters of the Commonwealth. This facility is located in a Zone II area.

**II. LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS**

Discharge permit limitations are as listed in the ground water permit and are in conformance with 314 CMR 5.00, the Groundwater Discharge Permit Program.

**III. PERMIT BASIS AND EXPLANATION OF EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS**

An Individual Groundwater Discharge permit is required for this discharge in accordance with the Massachusetts Clean Water Act, M.G.L. c. 21, s. 26-53 and 314 CMR 5.03.

Effluent limitations are based upon the location of the discharge, the level of treatment, consideration of human health protection criteria and protection of the ground waters of the Commonwealth.
